I. The Synoptic Problem (www.utoronto.ca/religion/synopsis)

- a.Mark has 661 vv.; Matthew has 1,068; Luke has 1,149
- b.80% of Mark's vv. are reproduced in Matthew and 65% in Luke
- c.220-235 vv. that Mark and Luke share that are not in Mark (strong agreement in word order leads to conclusion that they shared a written source)
- d.When Matthew and Luke preserve the same sequence, almost always stories that they share with Mark (Mt and Lk never agree against Mark's order) =
 Mark as source
- e.When Matthew and Luke differ about sequence, often the passage they share is <u>not</u> found in Mark. Most of these agreements are sayings of Jesus = \mathbf{Q}
- II. **Matthew's Five Major Blocks**: Sermon on the Mount (Mt 5-7); Instruction to Apostles (Mt 10); Parables of Kingdom (Mt 13); Other teachings on kingdom and church (Mt 18); Apocalyptic Discourse (Mt 23-27)

III. M and L Sources

- a. M: Magi, flight to Egypt, Jesus on almsgiving and prayer, parables of the treasure hidden in the field, the pearl of great price, the unmerciful servant, the ten virgins
- b. L: birth of John the Baptist, annunciation, shepherds visiting baby Jesus, Jesus as a 12-year old, Zacchaeus in the sycamore tree, good Samaritan, Lazarus and the rich man.
